



Student Right-to-Know Disclosure July 1, 2017

In accordance with the federal *Student Right-to-Know Act*, and to assist you in making an informed decision about your education, Fremont College has provided its graduation, retention and student body diversity rates as reported by the school in connection with the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) Survey. Annual Graduation Rate

The annual graduation rate is calculated based on a cohort of full-time, first-time, certificate-seeking students, enrolled from September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2011 and for whom 150% of the normal time for program completion has elapsed as of August 31, 2016. This rate does not include students who left school to serve in the armed forces (or have been called up to active duty), on an official church mission, or with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or for students who died or became permanently disabled.

Annual Retention Rates

Annual retention rates are calculated based on the percentage of *first-time bachelor's seeking students* enrolled from August 1, 2015 through October 31, 2015, who are still enrolled or have completed their program as of August 1, 2016. The retention rate is based on data reported by the school in connection with the IPEDS Survey. *These rates do not apply since Fremont's bachelor-level programs are Bachelor Degree Completion programs requiring entering students to already have earned an Associate degree or higher. Since these programs are completion programs students entering these programs are not considered first-time students.*
