In accordance with the federal *Student Right-to-Know Act*, and to assist you in making an informed decision about your education, Fremont University has provided its graduation, transfer-out, retention and student body diversity rates as reported by the school in connection with the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) Survey. Annual Graduation Rate

The annual graduation rate is calculated based on a cohort of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking students, enrolled from September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2017 and who completed their program within 150% of the normal time as of August 31, 2021. The graduation rate is based on data reported by the school in connection with the *2022-23 IPEDS Winter Collection (Graduation Rate Survey)*. This rate does not include students who left school to serve in the armed forces (or have been called up to active duty), on an official church mission, or with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or for students who died or became permanently disabled.

Annual Transfer-out Rate

The transfer-out rate is calculated based on a cohort of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking students, enrolled from September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2017, who are known to have transferred out of the school within 150% of the normal time as of August 31, 2022. The transfer-out rate is based on data reported by the school in connection with the *2022-23 IPEDS Winter Collection (Graduation Rate Survey)*.

Annual Retention Rates

Annual retention rates are calculated based on the percentage of first-time, bachelor’s seeking students, as of the enrolled from August 1, 2021 through October 31, 2021, who are still enrolled or have completed their program as of August 1, 2022. The retention rate is based on data reported by the school in connection with the *2022-23 IPEDS Spring Collection (Fall Enrollment Survey)*. *These rates do not apply since Fremont’s bachelor-level programs are Bachelor Degree Completion programs requiring entering students to already have earned an Associate degree or higher. Since these programs are completion programs students entering these programs are not considered first-time students.*
